The Knowledge Exchange Awards

After the resounding success of our 2022 and 2024 Knowledge Exchange Awards, we are thrilled to announce that the event is coming back in 2026. These prestigious awards celebrate the incredible knowledge exchange activity taking place between University of Exeter academics and our valued collaborators. Focusing on the best of our recent innovations and discoveries, the event recognises success in a range of regional, national and international companies.

The awards gala dinner will be held on Thursday 15 October 2026. It will be attended by our partner organisations, ranging from regional start-up companies to major international businesses, in addition to senior staff and members of our academic community. The event offers an excellent opportunity to learn about the research being conducted at the University and network with our diverse stakeholder and academic communities.

The awards are judged by experts in their field. In 2026 we will recognise success in 8 categories (detailed page 3). This year we are encouraging entries which focus on novel and innovative research which have exciting potential for the future, and established projects.

Category Sponsor

We are giving awards in 8 different categories, each of which focuses on a particular area of research impact. Organisations are invited to sponsor one of the following:

No. 1

Sustainable Futures Award

Recognising excellence in sustainability, environment and life sciences. Potential innovations can include products, policies, services and community partnerships.

No. 2

Health, Wellbeing and Life Sciences Award

Recognising innovations that lead us to better mental and physical wellbeing. Potential innovations can include products, policies, services and community partnerships.

No. 3

Fair, Just and Inclusive Society Award

Recognising innovations towards a more equitable, just and inclusive society. Potential innovations can include products, policies, services, community partnerships, and use of facilities.

No. 4

Commercialisation Project of the Year Award

Recognising significant impacts through licensing and/or venture development. This category includes spinouts, patents, and the practical application of research.

No. 5

Community Impact Award

Recognising a research or knowledge exchange project which worked with a community or non-profit partner and made a positive difference to people's lives.

No. 6

Bright Future Award 1: Student Innovation Award

Recognising excellent projects and activities in a real-world context. This category is open to current students and recent graduates (the activities must have been carried-out whilst a student at the University).

No. 7

Bright Future Award 2: Early Career Research Impact Award

Recognising excellent research and knowledge exchange in a real-world context. This category is open to staff with less than three years' experience at the University (the activities must have been carried-out whilst employed at the University).

No. 8

Knowledge Exchange Solution of the Year Award

Recognising excellence in Knowledge Exchange activities that turn new research and innovative ways of working into impactful solutions for real-world challenges. This category is open to academics and Professional Services teams who create significant benefits for partners, communities and industry.

- » Two tickets to attend Exeter Knowledge Exchange Awards gala dinner.
- » Branding of the Exeter Knowledge Exchange Awards to include:
 - One pop-up banner or similar material in the event foyer.
